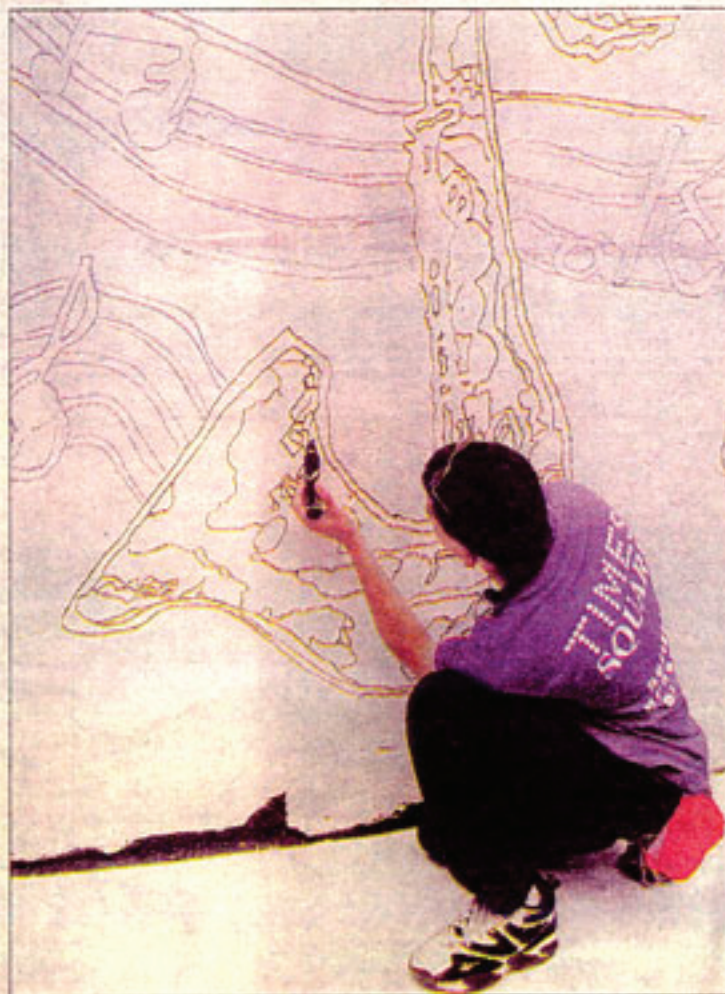

HUSTLERS AND BUSTLERS



The guys and dolls and hustling cabs and bikes and bustling buses of Broadway in the late '90s are frozen in time in 280-foot mural that covers the back side of Roseland Dance Hall. Recently finished, it's worth a trip to W. 53d St. for a look.

A daub here and a dab there — and careful heed to staying inside the lines — help giant mural take shape. Artist fills in colors of one of the tools of the Broadway musical trade — a saxophone (photo left) — and teamwork (photo right) captures the rush of Times Square. The finished product (below) towers tall over passersby. Conceived by artist Tom Christopher, it was executed by Peace Zone Street Muralists.
